
What You'll Experience

(DAYS 1 - 7)



DAY 1 – HELSINKI

Enjoy your first introduction to Nordic culture, design, and atmosphere

- Arrive in Helsinki and make your own way to your accommodation
- Check in to your centrally located hotel
- Spend the rest of the day at leisure exploring the city



DAY 2 – HELSINKI

Discover Helsinki's key highlights before beginning your memorable journey north toward the Arctic Circle.

- Join a guided walking tour highlighting Helsinki's most well-known landmarks
- Enjoy free time to explore the city at your own pace after the tour
- Make your own way to Helsinki Central Station
- Board the overnight Santa Claus Express to Kemi, travelling in a private sleeper cabin

DAY 3 – ROVANIEMI

Arrive in Rovaniemi and discover Lapland's winter scenery and Arctic experiences under the northern skies.


- Arrive in Rovaniemi and make your own way to your hotel

- Travel by coach to Luosto and check in to your hotel

DAY 5 – LUOSTO

Explore Lapland's wilderness on an unforgettable snowmobile adventure

- Enjoy a relaxed morning in the peaceful village of Luosto
- Spend time at leisure exploring the surrounding nature
- Head out in the afternoon on a guided snowmobile safari into the Arctic wilderness



DAY 6 – PYHÄ

Travel deeper into Lapland for remote Northern Lights experiences

- Transfer independently to the bus stop and travel by coach to Pyhä
- Check in to your Northern Lights cabin accommodation
- Enjoy leisure time in a quiet Arctic setting
- Join an evening guided Northern Lights hunt by car

DAY 7 – DEPARTURE

Say goodbye to Lapland as your winter journey comes to a close

- Enjoy breakfast at your accommodation
- Travel by coach to Rovaniemi Airport
- Depart Finland

Best Time to Travel

- This itinerary is best enjoyed between November and March, when winter landscapes, snow-based activities, and Northern Lights conditions are at their best.
