



Your Journey
(DAYS 1 - 10)



DAY 1 – REYKJAVIK

A relaxed start in Iceland's capital before your grand adventure begins.

- Arrive at Keflavík International Airport
- Self transfer to your centrally located Reykjavík hotel
- Check in to a 3/4-star hotel for a 1-night stay
- Evening at leisure



DAY 2 – GOLDEN CIRCLE

Iceland's most famous route filled with geological wonders.

- Morning pick-up from Reykjavík
- Visit Þingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Walk between the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates
- Explore the Geysir geothermal area with Strokkur eruptions
- Experience the power of Gullfoss waterfall
- Evening visit to Seljalandsfoss waterfall
- Overnight near the Golden Circle area

DAY 3 – SOUTH COAST

Classic waterfalls, black sand beaches, and an extraordinary ice cave.

- Visit Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls
- Guided glacier hike with certified guides and full safety equipment
- Explore the Katla Ice Cave
- Walk along Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach with basalt columns
- Overnight near Vík



DAY 4 – JÖKULSÁRLÓN

Icebergs, glacier landscapes, and unforgettable coastal scenery.

- Travel through Skaftafell National Park
- Visit Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon
- Amphibian boat ride among floating icebergs (seasonal)
- Walk along Diamond Beach
- Overnight near the Vatnajökull area





DAY 5 – THE EASTFJORDS

Remote fjords, fishing villages, and peaceful Icelandic countryside.

- Scenic drive through the Eastfjords
- Stops at coastal villages and viewpoints
- Visit Lake Lagarfljót and surrounding forest areas
- Optional visit to VÖK Baths
- Overnight in the Eastfjords region



DAY 6 – EAST ICELAND

Volcanic landscapes, waterfalls, and geothermal wonders.

- Visit Dimmuborgir lava formations
- Stop at Stuðlagil Canyon viewpoint
- Experience the power of Dettifoss waterfall
- Travel to Akureyri, the capital of North Iceland
- Evening at leisure in Akureyri



DAY 7 – NORTH ICELAND

Marine wildlife and legendary waterfalls.

- Travel to Hauganes village
- Included whale watching tour
- Visit Goðafoss, the Waterfall of the Gods
- Scenic drive to Borgarnes
- Overnight in West Iceland



DAY 8 – SNÆFELLSNES

The land of glaciers, lava fields, and iconic landmarks.

- Visit Gerðuberg basalt columns
- Stop at Ytri Tunga white-sand beach and seal colony
- Explore Djúpalónssandur black pebble beach
- Photograph Kirkjufell mountain
- Overnight in Stykkishólmur





DAY 9 – WEST ICELAND

Viking history, hot springs, and dramatic waterfalls.


- Visit Deildartunguhver hot spring
- Explore Reykholt, home of Snorri Sturluson
- Visit Hraunfossar and Barnafoss waterfalls
- Optional visit to Víðgelmir Lava Cave
- Return to Reykjavik in the evening
- Check in to a centrally located hotel for a 1-night stay



DAY 10 – DEPARTURE


Farewell Iceland after an unforgettable journey.

- Self transfer to Keflavík International Airport
- Departure home

Best Time to Travel
