





## DAY 1 – REYKJAVIK

A relaxed arrival day to settle into Iceland's vibrant capital.


- Arrive at Keflavík International Airport
- Self transfer to your centrally located hotel in Reykjavík
- Check in to a 3/4-star hotel for a 1-night stay
- Evening at leisure



## DAY 2 – GOLDEN CIRCLE

Iceland's most famous sights paired with winter magic.


- Morning pick-up from Reykjavík
- Visit Þingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Explore the Geysir geothermal area and see Strokkur erupt
- Experience the power of Gullfoss waterfall
- Overnight in countryside accommodation with private bathroom
- Northern Lights spotting opportunity if conditions allow



## DAY 3 – SOUTH COAST

Waterfalls, black sand beaches, and a thrilling glacier adventure.


- Walk behind Seljalandsfoss waterfall
- Discover the hidden Gjúfrabúi waterfall
- Visit Skógafoss waterfall
- Explore Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach with basalt columns
- Guided glacier hike with certified guides
- All safety equipment provided (helmet, harness, crampons, ice axe)
- Overnight in countryside accommodation




## DAY 4 – JÖKULSÁRLÓN

Icebergs, frozen landscapes, and a once-in-a-lifetime ice cave experience.

- Visit Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon
- Walk along Diamond Beach
- Super jeep journey to a natural blue ice cave
- Guided ice cave exploration
- Return to Reykjavik in the evening
- Check in to a centrally located hotel for a 1-night stay

Farewell Iceland, with unforgettable winter memories.

- Breakfast at your hotel
- Self transfer to Keflavík International Airport
- Departure home

## Best Time to Travel

- This tour is best from November to March, when winter conditions allow access to ice caves, Northern Lights viewing, and snow-covered landscapes that define the experience.

## Accommodation Style

- Stay in a combination of centrally located Reykjavík hotels and cozy countryside hotels or guesthouses during the guided tour. All accommodations feature private bathrooms and breakfast included.

## Pace & Physical Level

- This tour is designed at a moderate pace and is suitable for travelers in good general health. Glacier hiking requires normal mobility and comfort walking on uneven terrain.
