

DAY 1 – REYKJAVIK

DAY 2 – SNÆFELLSNES

- Morning hotel pick-up in Reykjavík
- Travel to the Snæfellsnes Peninsula by premium minibus
- Visit dramatic coastal cliffs, black beaches, and lava fields
- See the iconic Kirkjufell Mountain and surrounding scenery
- Explore Arnarstapi fishing village and local seal colonies
- Overnight in a countryside hotel or guesthouse with private bathroom

DAY 3 – GOLDEN CIRCLE

Discover Iceland's most famous sightseeing route in a single unforgettable day.


- Visit Thingvellir National Park

DAY 4 – SOUTH COAST

Experience Iceland's glacial heart before returning to the capital.

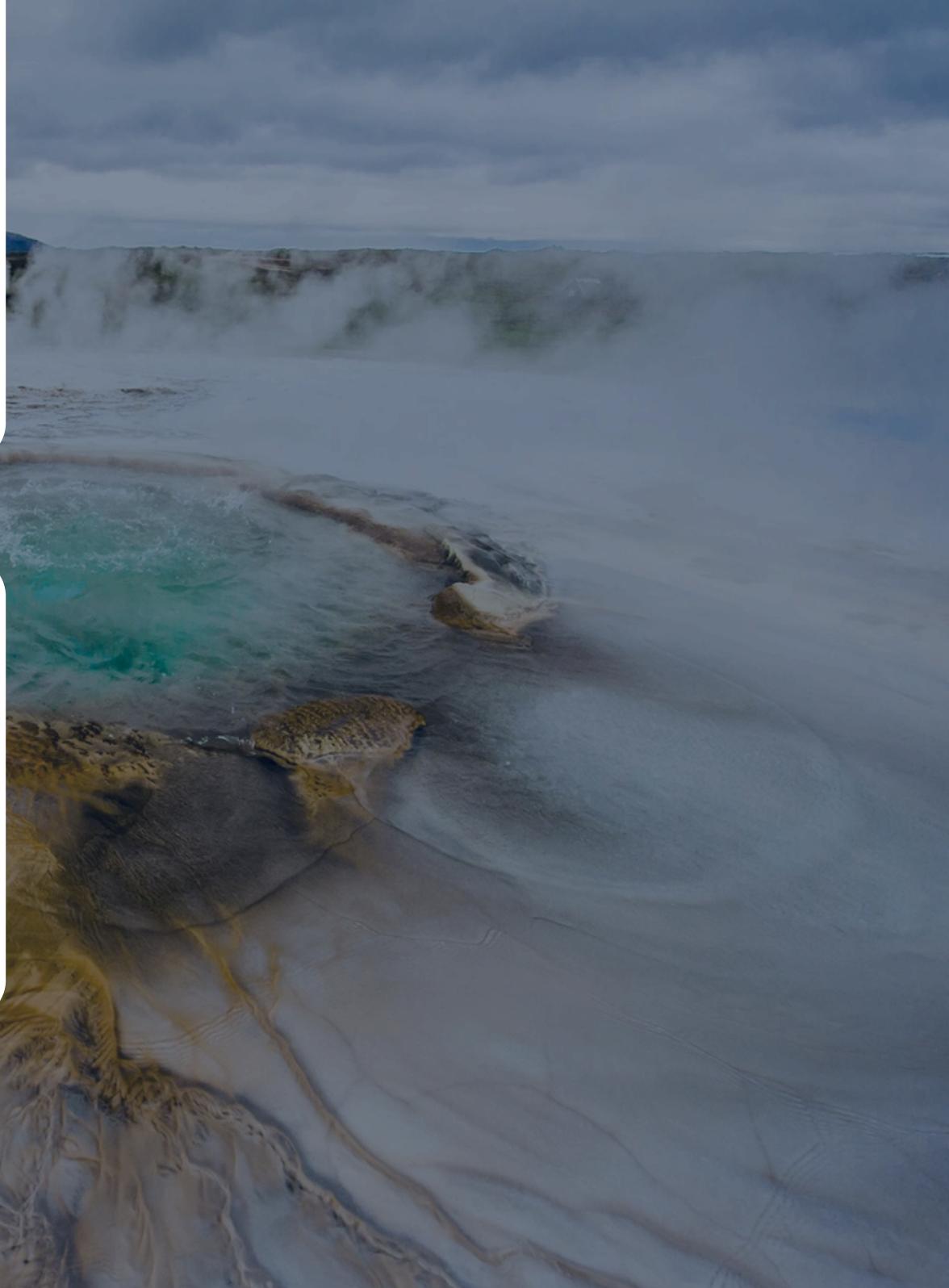
- Visit Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon

- Use provided safety equipment including helmet, harness, crampons, and ice axe
- Return to Reykjavik in the evening
- Check in to your centrally located hotel
- Evening at leisure to explore Reykjavík



DAY 6 – DEPARTURE

- Breakfast at your hotel
- Self-transfer to Keflavík International Airport
- Departure home

Best Time to Travel

- This tour is best from November to March, when winter conditions allow access to ice caves, Northern Lights viewing, and snow-covered landscapes that define the experience.

- Stay in a combination of centrally located Reykjavík hotels and cozy countryside hotels or guesthouses during the guided tour. All accommodations feature private bathrooms and breakfast included.

Pace & Physical Level

- This tour is designed at a moderate pace and is suitable for travelers in good general health. Glacier hiking requires normal mobility and comfort walking on uneven terrain.
