

DAY 1 – REYKJAVIK

Welcome to Iceland and the beginning of your grand winter adventure.


- Arrive at Keflavík International Airport
- Self-transfer to your accommodation in Reykjavík
- Check in to your centrally located 3–4 star hotel
- Spend the evening at leisure



DAY 2 – GOLDEN CIRCLE

Begin your guided journey through Iceland's most famous sightseeing route.

- Morning hotel pick-up in Reykjavík
- Visit Þingvellir National Park and UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Explore the Geysir geothermal area and see Strokkur erupt
- Witness the power of Gullfoss waterfall
- Stop at Seljalandsfoss waterfall
- Overnight in a countryside hotel in South Iceland



DAY 3 – SOUTH COAST

Experience waterfalls, coastal scenery, and a thrilling glacier hike.


- Travel along Iceland's dramatic South Coast
- Join a guided glacier hike with certified guides
- Use provided safety equipment including helmet, harness, crampons, and ice axe
- Visit Skógafoss waterfall
- Explore Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach and basalt columns

DAY 4 – JÖKULSÁRLÓN

Discover Iceland's glacial heart and a true winter highlight.

- Travel east through Skaftafell National Park
- Visit Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon
- Walk along Diamond Beach among sparkling icebergs
- Enter a natural Blue Ice Cave with professional guides
- Overnight near Vatnajökull Glacier





DAY 5 – EASTFJORDS

Journey through one of Iceland's most remote and tranquil regions.

- Travel through the spectacular Eastfjords
- Stop at small fishing villages and scenic fjords
- Visit Lagarfljót Lake and surrounding landscapes
- Look out for wild reindeer along the way
- Optional visit to VÖK Baths
- Overnight in the Eastfjords region



DAY 6 – AKUREYRI


Explore North Iceland's volcanic and geothermal wonders.

- Visit Dimmuborgir lava formations
- Explore Námaskarð geothermal area
- Stop at Goðafoss waterfall
- Arrive in Akureyri, the capital of North Iceland
- Evening at leisure to explore the town

DAY 7 – HAUGANES

Enjoy wildlife encounters and coastal scenery in North Iceland.


- Travel to the coastal village of Hauganes
- Join a whale watching tour in Eyjafjörður
- Look for humpback whales, minke whales, dolphins, and porpoises
- Overnight in North or West Iceland



DAY 8 – BORGARNES

Discover West Iceland's natural wonders and Viking heritage.

- Visit Deildartunguhver, Europe's most powerful hot spring
- Explore Hraunfossar and Barnafoss waterfalls
- Visit Reykholt, home of Snorri Sturluson
- Overnight in the Borgarnes area





DAY 9 – SNÆFELLSNES

Conclude your Ring Road journey in one of Iceland's most scenic regions.


- Explore the Snæfellsnes Peninsula
- Visit Djúpalónssandur black pebble beach
- See the iconic Kirkjufell Mountain
- Return to Reykjavik in the evening
- Check in to your centrally located hotel
- Spend the evening at leisure



DAY 10 – CITY


Say goodbye to Iceland with unforgettable winter memories.

Best Time to Travel

- This tour is best from November to March, when winter conditions allow access to ice caves, Northern Lights viewing, and snow-covered landscapes that define the experience.

Accommodation Style

- Stay in a combination of centrally located Reykjavík hotels and cozy countryside hotels or guesthouses during the guided tour. All accommodations feature private bathrooms and breakfast included.

Pace & Physical Level

- This tour is designed at a moderate pace and is suitable for travelers in good general health. Glacier hiking requires normal mobility and comfort walking on uneven terrain.
