





DAY 1 – COPENHAGEN

- Self-transfer to your accommodation

DAY 4 – STOCKHOLM

Uncover Stockholm's royal heritage and maritime past on a guided sightseeing experience through the city's most celebrated landmarks.

DAY 6 – GOTHENBURG


See Gothenburg from a new perspective on a guided river cruise, followed by time to enjoy the city's laid-back coastal charm.

DAY 10 – BERGEN



Explore Bergen's historic heart and surrounding scenery, from medieval Bryggen to sweeping viewpoints above the city.

DAY 11 – DEPARTURE


Conclude your Scandinavian journey and depart Norway with lasting memories of cities, rail journeys, and dramatic fjord landscapes.
