




What You'll Experience

DAY 6 – GOTHENBURG


See Gothenburg from a new perspective on a guided river cruise, followed by time to enjoy the city's laid-back coastal charm.

- Fjord sightseeing cruise aboard a silent electric boat
- Audio-guided experience with panoramic windows
- Access to outdoor decks, blankets, and onboard facilities
- Afternoon and evening at leisure






DAY 9 – CITY
